The club will only get through and watch the first four movies of the series. By signing this permission slip, you acknowledge you are aware of this rating, the elements in the movie (including the practice of magic, witchcraft, and wizardry), and give permission to San Tan Learning Center to show and discuss the following movies to your child(ren):

Harry Potter and the Sorcerer's Stone (2001) – rated PG – *Rescued from the outrageous neglect of his aunt and uncle, a young boy with a great destiny proves his worth while attending Hogwarts School of Witchcraft and Wizardry.* (www.imdb.com)

Harry Potter and the Chamber of Secrets (2002) – rated PG - *Harry ignores warnings not to return to Hogwarts, only to find the school plagued by a series of mysterious attacks and a strange voice haunting him.* (www.imdb.com)

Harry Potter and the Prisoner of Azkaban (2004) – rated PG – *It's Harry's third year at Hogwarts; not only does he have a new "Defense Against the Dark Arts" teacher, but there is also trouble brewing. Convicted murderer Sirius Black has escaped the Wizards' Prison and is coming after Harry.* (www.imdb.com)

Harry Potter and the Goblet of Fire – rated PG – *Harry finds himself selected as an underaged competitor in a dangerous multi-wizardary school competition.* (www.imdb.com)
